We have so much fun here at Water's Edge that sometime we just forget some of the requirement that we may not always deal with. I would like to offer you some friendly reminders.

1. Remember any and all Site Improvements **MUST** be approved by the Park Mgr. with proper paper work.
2. Copies of Insurance for Golf Carts must be turned in annually.
3. Pet Vaccination paper work must be turned in annually.
4. Please check in to make sure your contact info is up-to-date in the office.
5. Check with the Mail Room to make sure you have plenty of labels to return your mail after you leave.
6. When renting your site to a renter, make sure you supply them with the proper paper work, as well as the rules that they must follow. These forms must be signed by you as well as the renter, and they must produce a copy to the office when registering.
7. Let's all check our speed; it's 10 and not 25 - 35. It's also your responsibility to let your Guest and Service people know that we have a 10MPH Speed limit in the park, and this is year round.
8. It's been brought to my attention that we had a volunteer trash collector that was cut while

collecting trash. Please, please, do not throw your Broken Glass in the plastic bags. Put it into a coffee can or safe container.

9. Please break down your corrugated boxes to help out our volunteers.
10. When you submit a problem in writing, please be sure to give it directly to Gary the Park Mgr. so he can discuss it with you and come to a resolution. It must be signed with your contact info.
11. Let's all work with Lisa and help her maintain our rest rooms. If you accidentally spill something and create a mess, please clean it up or ask for assistance from the office.
12. Be respectful of the hours that are posted for cleaning.
