

Important Alligator Awareness

In the State of Florida there are alligators in most of the bodies of water, **we are no exception**, please use caution at all times as alligators come and go in our pond throughout the year.

During the months of April thru June, it is Alligator Mating Season, alligators become more active during this period – please be aware that we normally have alligators in the pond in the park, you may see them lying on the waters’ edge sunning themselves and on occasion, in other areas of the park.

*****PLEASE DO NOT APPROACH AT ANY TIME!!!*** DO NOT walk your pets by the water ***at any time*** and ALWAYS keep them on a leash, please use caution when walking at all times as alligators do come and go in the pond throughout the year.**

*****DO NOT FEED THE ALLIGATORS***** Also, if you go out during the evening hours, or at any time, please be aware of your surroundings. Always walk with a flashlight. If you do see an alligator that becomes aggressive in any way, **PLEASE** contact myself or Bob Halsey (he will contact me) and I will contact the proper authorities. **Thank you.**
