Project News:

The sewer project on our existing thirteen S-Row rental lots is complete, and they are ready for January 1 reservations. We have also completed majority of work on our additional new eleven lots, with the exception of trees and landscaping, which will be done in the spring. The water, sewer, electrical, concrete pads, stone driveways, and sod have been completed on new P-Row lots. FP&L will make the final electrical connection to transformers next week and the new lots will be ready for January rental. The majority, or two thirds of the \$400,000 project expense that was set aside for the sewer and lot expansion project, was spent for sewers on twenty-four total lots, and water on eleven new lots. The remainder was for lot excavation and grading, electrical, concrete, stone driveways, and sod on our eleven new lots.

So, as we complete and put the lot expansion project to rest, we will now be focusing on our 7,200 square foot multipurpose building that will house our office, recreational hall, post office, kitchen, bathrooms, and many other amenities. Our project budget for the building is \$200 per square foot or 1.4 million dollars. Building permits have been submitted for the initial project work, including excavation and grading, structural concrete, and installation of structural steel. This work will be followed with electrical, plumbing, HVAC, and rough framing. The building project is expected to start by the end of January and is expected to take one year from groundbreaking to complete. Funds for both projects have been procured through lot sales, insurance proceeds, and reserve funds. Another update will be provided at our January board meeting.

Both carts should keep score and keep track of drives used


