## *Glen and the Water's Edge Guys*

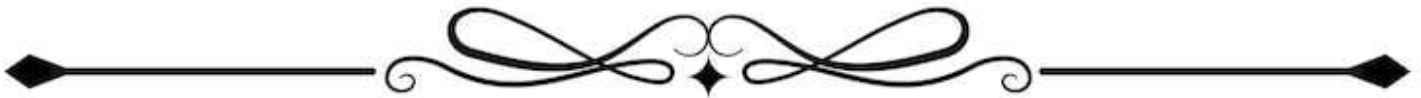
